### **PROTECTED SPECIES MAP**

We had 3 sites that have bats roosting/nesting:

1. Site NPO28
2. In the southern CA at Mark Isaac's house, High Street.
3. In the David Wilson Homes site.

Otter mother and 2 babies have been reported in the Ock, south east of Penstones. No photographic evidence at this time.

A Barn Owl is nesting/roosting in the Thatcher's Barn. Seen recently.

An Adder has been seen in Georges Field (Sandels) where new homes (DW) are being built in 1999.

An Adder was seen and a dog bitten in a Prior Close garden. In the last 6 months.

A Great Crested Newt was seen in a pond in St Deny's garden 2009.

A Smooth snake was seen in St Denys Garden in the past.

A Water Vole was seen in the southern Ock behind CA, Ock Meadow houses and Penstones.
